Operates best with effective leadership.




TIPS:

CDC Worksite Health ScoreCard (HSC)



- Guides the development of a comprehensive worksite health promotion program
 - Evidence-based individual risk reduction programs
 - + Environmental supports for healthy behaviors
 - + Organizational policies and healthy worksite activities
- Validated worksite tool
- Allows for comparisons with other worksites


